What is cadastral data?

Cadastral data is the digital representation of the boundary definition of all land parcels within Western Australia.

In what formats is the data available?

Shapefile

DXF

ESRI File Geodatabase

GeoPackage

How often is the data updated?

Cadastral data is updated daily to SLIP. Via Geodata the most frequent available delivery is weekly.

Are incremental updates available?

Incremental/change files are not available at this stage, however; queries can be applied to the data using change date attributes contained within the data.
