## **NOTICE TO SURVEYORS T2/2000**

## IMPLEMENTATION OF LODGING OF DEPOSITED PLANS AND THE CEASING OF DUPLICATE MINI PLAN PRODUCTION

As of July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2000, <u>all</u> freehold survey documents have been lodged as "Deposited Plans" (ie. both the A3 and A2 sizes are referred to as "DP's"). The first commencing deposited plan number was DP24326.

The production of duplicate mini plans will cease - except for those plans and diagrams certified correct and awaiting a release letter or pegging certificate, and presently stored in Freehold Plan Registration.

Deposited plans when subdivided or partially superseded will not have new subdivisions cross-indexed onto them. Only when there is an existing mini plan will the cross-indexing of new subdivisions be carried out. All deposited plans will be cross-indexed onto the Survey Index Plans.

The State Law Publisher has advised DOLA that the new plan forms will not be printed until October. Therefore, the 3 months transition period for the introduction of the new forms (as advised in Notice T1/2000), has been extended for a further two months. Those surveyors that have prepared their own forms are encouraged to continue lodging plans using the new format.
