Consultation period for draft revised guidelines

Review of the Western Australian Land Surveyors Licensing Board Special Survey Area Guidelines

The Notices to Surveyors <u>T4-2017</u> and <u>T5-2017</u> provided information about the Landgate and Land Surveyors Licensing Board (LSLB) review of the Special Survey Area (SSA) Guidelines and an invitation to provide input either directly to me or via a survey.

This feedback has now been collated and much of it included in a draft set of guidelines attached with this notice.

Two versions are provided – one with all the material changes <u>tracked</u>, and a "<u>clean</u>" version to check more easily on readability etc.

The major changes concern the following matters:

- Regulatory, agency and terminology updates
- Spatial positioning updates
- Initial control marks
- Permanent final marking
- Offset corner marks
- Final marking in rural subdivisions
- Final Survey Certificates

Whilst there has been moderate support for bringing AHD levels onto final control points, this concept requires further development and so has not been included now. A discussion paper about this matter will be published as a follow-up to this notice.
