1 Document Purpose

This document describes the Sales Evidence data offered by Landgate and is a guide and reference for analysts and decision makers to make an assessment on the suitability of the product for their business.

2 What is Sales Evidence data

For the purposes of this document the Sales Evidence data contains information about the sale of freehold and leasehold properties within Western Australia. The data is captured from Transfer of Land registration documents and merged with attribute data from the valuations process to provide information about sales price and dates, parcel details, number of bedrooms, bathrooms and a range of other building attributes. The sales database stores records dating back to 1988. Sales Evidence data, if purchased in conjunction with Tenure data, can also include attributes from the Tenure record which are; Certificate of Title number and Buyer/Seller details.

3 Background

The Sales Evidence database stores records dating back to 1988 with approximately 50,000 – 80,000 new records transacted each year.

Sales Evidence data includes:

- unique PIN number
- parcel identifier
- property street address
- sale price and date
- building attributes such as bedrooms and bathrooms
- incremental updates

If purchased in conjunction with Tenure data, Sales Evidence data can also include the Certificate of Title Number and Buyer/Seller details.

These attributes are not available when Sales Evidence is purchased as a standalone or with any other datasets except Tenure data.

4 Product Overview

Landgate offers customers the ability to obtain an extract of Sales Evidence data in a CSV format (Comma Separated Values) for a specific area of interest (eg: Locality, Local Government Area) or whole of State. This document provides information on the field names and attributes of the fields in the data set.

5 Metadata (Data Accuracy/Completeness/Currency)

5.1 Data Source

The data is extracted from Landgate's valuation database "Valsys", and is the authoritative Sales Evidence data captured for the State. Sales Evidence data is captured for individual properties as a result of the sale of a property.

5.2 Currency

Data is captured daily as part of the registration process and is exported to the Sales Evidence database nightly. Data updates are available weekly as incremental updates.

5.3 Coverage Completeness

The whole of State with records dating back to 1988.

5.4 Accuracy

The information contained within the dataset is taken from documents lodged at Landgate (or another agency) and is entered into Landgate systems with no further verification process and is completely reliant on information provided by the vendor or another source. Information is gathered from many sources including State and Local Government Agencies and physical site inspections.

5.5 Format

The dataset's initial extract is available only in fixed length (refer to Table 1 below) comma separated values file format (.csv). This can be copied into an excel (.xls) file if required. In addition, updates to the initial extract are available in excel, pdf and adobe.

6 Accessing the Data

Sales Evidence data can be purchased/accessed in three (3) ways depending on the customer need;

- transactional
- annual access/subscription
- reseller partnership agreements

These options are explained in more detail below.

6.1 Transactional

Customers can purchase the data as either whole of State or an area of interest as a once off purchase for internal business use (referred to as "transactional"). It is charged on a per record basis with an associated extraction and provision fee. Please contact your Account Manager or Customer Services for further information.

6.2 Annual Access licence

An Annual Access licence provides for an agreed periodic delivery of the data to the customer for the approved purpose as outlined in the terms and conditions of the Annual Access License. The agreement is negotiated between the customer and Landgate. For further information, please contact Customer Services and ask to speak to an Account Manager.

8.1 Attribute Name: ST_SUFFIX

This table lists the available values for the field ST_SUFFIX, the full name and a description of each value.

ACCS	Access	A minor road built specially to give access to a house, motorway, etc.
ALLY	Alley	A roadway, usually narrow, for people or vehicles in cities and towns. A minor roadway through the centre of city blocks or squares.
