



3.113 Pensioner Rating Rebate

Purpose/Objectives

Pensioners and other concession card holders may be eligible for a rate rebate on their local government rates on residential properties. Requests may be received from local governments to provide separate unimproved values for the purposes of residential rate rebates.

Key Principles

Rate rebate requests are made under the Rates and Charges (Rebates and Deferments) Act 1992.

If a property is on a lot with more than one home and is not strata-titled, rebates may be apportioned according to the ownership interests and the extent the owner uses the property for residential purposes.

If a farm is partially used for commercial purposes, the unimproved value will be apportioned according to the ownership interests and the extent that the property is used as a residence.
